Hello everyone! I just wanted to send out our yearly letter to ALL GRADES letting parents know what to expect from all the bands as we head into the final months of the year. Remember that admissions to all performance events at the school are free and that all performance events are graded events for students in the class.

- **Tuesday March 6th @ 2:45 P.M.- Leetonia High School Concert Band Performs At Hubbard High School-** The Leetonia Concert Band will be performing at Hubbard High School for three music judges with a critique session to follow the performance. Details of this event will be send home in a separate form to the high school band members.
- **Friday May 11th @ 6:00 P.M- H.S. Band Banquet and Awards Ceremony-** 8th grade marchers from the 2017-18 season are invited to this as well as all high school band members. You will be receiving an invitation to attend the event at Leetonia High School. All marching band members will have their meals paid for and all guests will have a per plate charge. This will be detailed in the mailing/flyer home. All students should make plans to attend and this is a dress-up occasion!
- **Monday May 14th @ 7:00 P.M- Fifth and Sixth Grade Spring Concert-** Fifth and Sixth grade concert bands will be performing their final concert of the 2017-2018 school year. Students should arrive at the school by 6:30 P.M. for warm-ups. Attire is dress pants/skirt and dress shirt. Please, no T-Shirts, jeans or tennis shoes. Pretend you are in a symphony! These students are looking forward to playing their very best for you and we hope that you can attend!!! Concert will take place in the H.S. Gymnasium. **Students will be required to stay for the entire event as both bands will be on the floor the entire concert.**
- **Monday May 21st @ 6:00 P.M- LHS Spring Arts Festival-** Come and enjoy a night of music and crafts as the High School and 7/8 Bands perform and the high school art program is put on display for all to see! A night not to be missed! Bring a friend...or THREE!! 😊 Attire for 7/8 is dress up with no jeans/sweatpants/t-Shirts/flip-flops/Tennis Shoes permitted please. High school is the customary white and black attire discussed in class.
- **Friday May 25th @ 9 A.M- Class Day-** This is an event held during the school day for the senior class. Dress for the event is Black/White and students will be permitted to change once the event concludes at 10:45 A.M.
- **Sunday May 27th @ 1 P.M-Commencement-** Students are to arrive at the school no later than 12:30 P.M. for seating and warm up prior to guests arriving for the ceremony. Dress is Black/White and the event should conclude around 2:15 P.M.
- **Monday May 28th @ 10:00 A.M- Memorial Day Parade-** Students are to arrive at the deer processing plant in Washingtonville by 9:30 A.M to warm-up. Parade steps off at 10 A.M. and ends at the Washingtonville V.F.W .. Attire: Marching uniform and marching shoes/black socks. Event should end around 11:15 A.M. and students can be picked up at the school when it is over. Uniform check in will take place after the event. Please be patient as we will have to check in each uniform prior to the student being dismissed.

As an aside, please bear in mind that class day, commencement and Memorial Day are a part of the final nine weeks grade. (I enter high school Tuesday morning.) The course description states that we are a co-curricular class and we have had a great many people requesting to start vacations at that time.
