# DRESS CODE/OBLIGATIONS/HONORS

The following are some reminders to help prevent any last minute worries:

- Credits needed for graduation are not certified **until the day of commencement practice**. Therefore, all senior final exams and required class work must be satisfactorily completed prior to this time.
- All fees and obligations must be satisfied before Class Day.
- Caps and gowns will be distributed the week of May 1<sup>st</sup> as soon as verification that all financial obligations to the school district have been met.
- **Proper attire must be worn in order for students to participate in the graduation ceremonies.**
- Girls: Dresses or skirt and blouse. Hemline of skirt/dress should be above gown length. Black or neutral sandals or dress shoes with a comfortable height of heel. Jewelry should be small and tasteful.
- Boys: White or solid colored dress shirt, dark, solid colored dress slacks, long tie (NO bow ties), and dark dress shoes. NO TENNIS SHOES OR SANDALS.
- **Only ONE facial piercing will be permitted.**
- **NO BLUE JEANS, SHORTS, ATHLETIC SHOES, OR FLIP FLOPS ARE PERMITTED.**

Please observe the following guidelines for the wearing of caps and gowns:

- Caps are always worn flat on top of the head with the point of the cap centered in the middle of the forehead.
- Tassels are worn on the **right** side of the cap until the time honors of commencement are bestowed upon the graduate.
- **Caps are never to be worn at the back of the head!**
- Gowns should be approximately ten inches from the floor (please hem if necessary). Your gown should be neat, clean, and **wrinkle free** before being worn to any of the graduation exercises.
